light and make a left onto Forbes Rd.

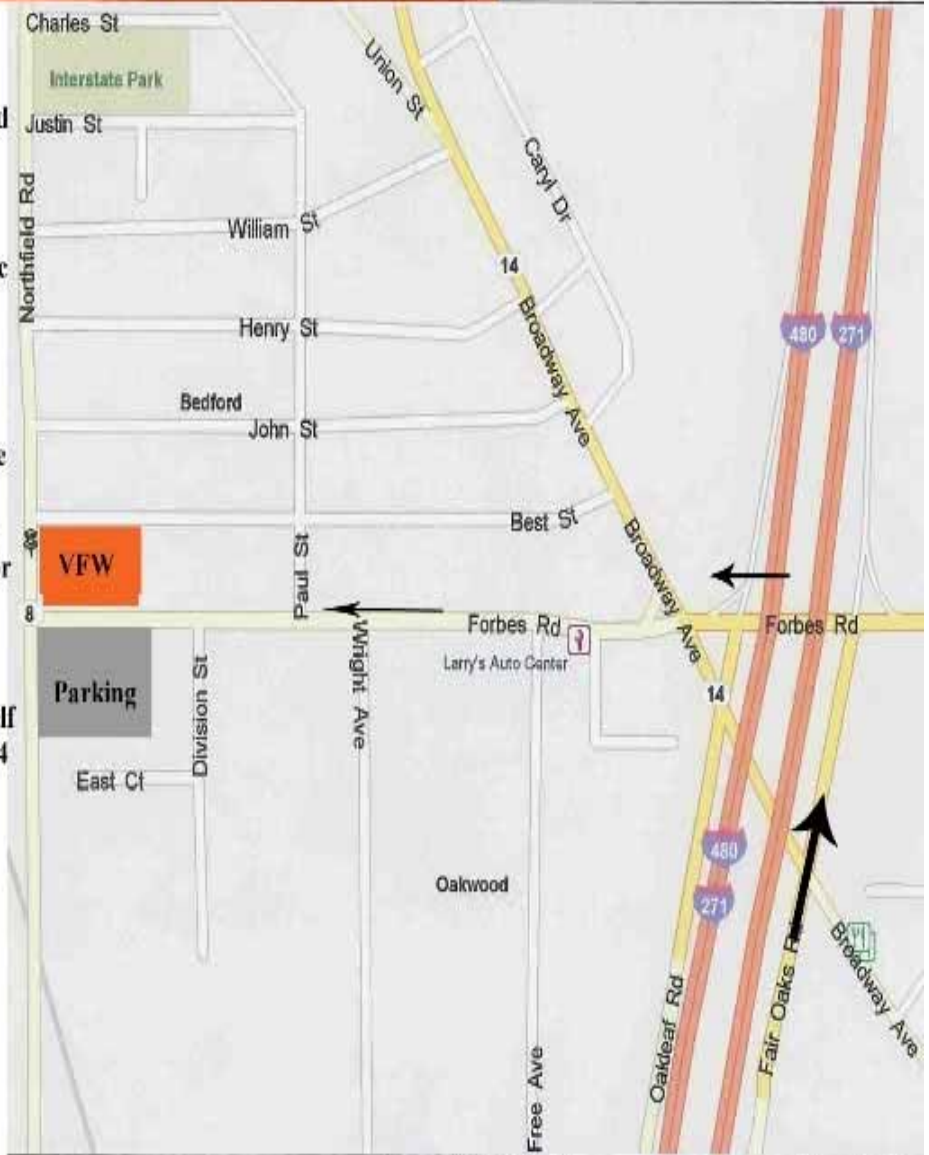
Coming from the north on 271 get off at the
