## President's Report

First of all I would like to wish all of you a HAPPY NEW YEAR! May it be a safe one for all. 2010 brings some changes in the Ohio APV laws.

As we begin a new year of riding I wanted to share what I have learned about the changes in ATV (APV per Ohio law).

- 1) TRESPASSING– The old law was a 4th degree misdemeanor with a \$250 fine and up to 30 days in jail. The new law is still a 4th degree misdemeanor but the fine has doubled to \$500 and if convicted 3 times your registration/license plate can be impounded for a maximum of 60 days.
- 2) Registration will now be required for all APV's even if using only on private property. The only exceptions APV's used for farming.
- 3) Beginning in July 2010, license plates and validation stickers will be required for APV's; renewed every three years. Trial bikes and snowmobiles are exempt. So the next time you go to renew your APV make room for a license plate.
- 4) Finally, if you are less than 16 years of age you must be accompanied by an adult in order to operate an APV or snowmobile. Otherwise the responsible person that the machine is registered to will be fined up to \$500 and 30 days in jail.
