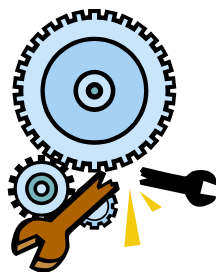
October 20-22 Mud Drags at Four Seasons in West Finley, PA
