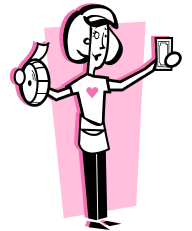

What better way to see Montana's "Big Sky Country" than from the seat of your ATV? This is possible at EagleRider Adventure Ranch in Fort Benton, MT where you can ride your own ATV or rent one of theirs. EagleRider offers a 5,000 acre private adventure ranch where you or a group will enjoy the trails and views all to yourself.

The private land sits in the middle of the Upper Missouri River Breaks National Monument, the same land that over 200 years ago Lewis and Clark called "wild and scenic." The Monument is a pristine stretch of the Missouri River and has remained unchanged except by nature, essentially keeping the same look as when the famous explorers traveled through.

EagleRider offers a variety of guided tours including: ATVs, hiking, and an auto tour. The scenic ATV tour will take you past huge canyons that flourish with wildlife and close to white rock cliffs that could be the backdrop of a movie scene. The famous Hole-in-the-Wall white rock structure can be seen via the hiking tour.

If a guided tour isn't for you, EagleRider-Central Montana rents ATV equipment, allowing for more of a personal approach to sight-see and enjoy the scenery. You can hit the highways or mountain trails on board a dual sport Kawasaki motorcycle. The Ranch also rents Harley-Davidson motorcycles, which can be ridden to various National Parks such as Glacier and Yellowstone.
